Course Marshal

- Communicate when required to Event Control which may include updates on riders or reporting issues/emergencies on course.

- Provide directional assistance to riders
- · Alert riders to upcoming hazards
- Interact with and encourage riders during the event to ensure the best and safest possible experience is had by all
- · Be alert and maintain your position until Broom wagon comes past with the last rider
